THE LEWIS AND CLARK EXPEDITION

Commissioned by President Thomas Jefferson; officially called the Corps of Discovery; main goal was to find northern water route between Atlantic and Pacific oceans

Led by army officers Meriwether Lewis and William Clark; lasted from May 1804 through September 1806


Journey began and ended in St. Louis; the Corps reached the Pacific Ocean bordering present-day Oregon

Clark served as naturalist and kept a detailed journal of the new plants and animal species discovered

Failed in main mission to find Northwest Passage; information gathered about the land, plants, and animals and successful interaction with Native American groups proved valuable
